SUBJECT: OPENING DATES FOR SEMESTER I, 2021


Kenya Water Institute wishes to notify all the continuing students regarding resumption of learning in all their respective Campuses as follows;

- a) The opening date for semester I, 2021 will be **6th January, 2021**.
- b) The Institute has developed a new Mode of Learning - (**the Blended Learning Mode**) - to effectively administer the respective Courses via an online learning platform - while **Practicals** will be offered at the respective Campuses, with Learners being present for practicals. All continuing students except Plumbing and pipefitting (PPF) and Water Operators Course (WOC) students will be registered for the blended mode of learning while new students will be registered for full time face –to- face learning during the first semester only.
- c) All September intake classes must proceed for their Industrial Attachment from **January, 2021**. Any assistance can be obtained from the offices of Deans’ of Students in their respective campuses.
- d) Fees payment must be made by **6th January, 2021** and banking slips scanned and uploaded in the respective campuses e-mails as shown below;

Your name and admission number must appear on the banking slip. Those paying by way of cheque must also scan the schedule from the paying

institution. Please keep the originals safe for receipting when you come for practicals.

- e) Sensitization on e-learning will take place from **7th to 12th January, 2021**. Online classes will start on 13th January, 2021 and login details will be sent to those who will have paid the recommended minimum fee by **6th January, 2021**. The time table for e-learning, practicals and examinations will be posted on the KEWI website.
- f) All students must ensure they have NHIF card or any other medical insurance card. The Institution is making arrangement to offer basic medical services within campuses or in collaboration with health care institutions neighboring our campuses. This will be useful when students are in campuses for face to face learning. The medical fee will not be refundable from **January, 2021**.
- g) The available limited accommodation in **Nairobi and Chiakariga campuses** will be reserved for the new students only. All continuing students are advised to make alternative accommodation arrangements when they are in their respective campuses for face to face learning. Assistance can be obtained from Deans' of Students offices in the respective campuses.
