SUBJECT: EXAMINATIONS DATES FOR SEMESTER I, 2021 AND OPENING DATES FOR SEMESTER II, 2021

Kenya Water Institute wishes to notify all the continuing students regarding the resumption of learning in their respective Campuses as follows;

- a. Date for resumption of semester 1, 2021 is **10th May, 2021**.
- b. The examination dates for semester 1 will be from **12th May, 2021 to 19th May, 2021**
- c. All students to clear semester I fees by **7th May 2021**
- d. The opening date for semester II, 2021 will be **24th May, 2021**.
- e. The January 2018 and January 2019 intake classes must proceed for their Industrial Attachment from **June, 2021**. Any assistance can be obtained from the offices of Deans' of Students in their respective campuses.
- f. The January 2020 intake class to proceed for their community service from **June, 2021**. Any assistance can be obtained from the offices of Deans' of Students in their respective campuses.
- g. Fees payment for semester II must be made by **24th May, 2021** and banking slips scanned and uploaded in the respective campuses e-mails as shown below;

The fee payment should be made through KCB bank account number **1107760585** or through M-pesa pay bill number **4004040** the account number being the '**student's registration number/surname**' e.g. if your registration number is **DWE1/J07698/2018** then the account number should be captured as '**J07698/SURNAME**'.

Your name and admission number must appear on the banking slip. Those paying by way of cheque must also scan the schedule from the paying institution. Please keep the originals safe for receipting.

- h. The available limited accommodation in **Nairobi and Chiakariga campuses** will be reserved for the new students only. All continuing students are advised to make alternative accommodation arrangements when they are in their respective campuses for face to face learning. Assistance can be obtained from Deans' of Students offices in the respective campuses.
